RECONSTRUCTION: On 08/25/18 between 0200 hours and 0300 hours, a black sedan with five suspects followed, [REDACTED] a homeless male on Mile Stretch Drive. The passenger had a CO2 charged BB air pistol and fired numerous rounds at [REDACTED] stopped his bicycle on Mile Stretch Drive and the vehicle circled [REDACTED] and continued to fire BBs at him. [REDACTED] kicked the vehicle's driver front panel because it got to close then he rammed his bicycle into the car. [REDACTED] travelled west on Mile Stretch and the black sedan continued to follow him and firing BBs from behind. The vehicle passed [REDACTED] and the shooter continued to fire BBs at [REDACTED] while they were in front of him. It was later found the same vehicle was on US Highway 19 and fired upon [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was struck in the chest leaving injury to the left pectoral with a deep bruise. The black sedan was seen turning east on Mile Stretch Drive from US Highway 19 and a felony stop took place at the Fifth-Third Bank located at 1956 Abacus Road. Five juveniles were arrested for aggravated battery with a deadly weapon and transported to the Land O'Lakes Juvenile Detention Center.

CRIME SCENE: Mile Stretch Road, Between 1929 US Highway 19 and 1956 Abacus Road, and an unknown location along US Highway 19, Holiday.

INTERVIEW #1: [REDACTED] stated the following:

[REDACTED] and other homeless people have been antagonized by unknown persons three times a week for the past three weeks. They appeared to be a group of kids and it would stem from harsh verbal language exchange to throwing bricks and rocks at them and now the shooting. [REDACTED] was on his bike across the street from WAWA in the plaza. He decided to ride east on Mile Stretch Drive and a black sedan approached him from behind and was about three car links behind him. He heard "tink tink tink" on his bike. The sedan came along-side him and the passenger stuck a pistol out of the window and began firing at him. He said the BBs were hitting his bike but not him.

The passengers were yelling at home and making fun of him. They made comments such as "Give me a dollar", "Fucking pussy", and "Homeless Fucker".

While he was being fired at, the person in the back side, behind the shooter, had his phone out and appeared to be taking video of the shooting. He said the shooter was possibly a white/black mix male with a white or red shirt. He was using a CO2 pistol. [REDACTED] couldn't get away from the car so he stopped riding. The car kept doing "donuts" around him as the shooter kept shooting at him. He said the shooter pointed the gun at him at ten feet away and fired at least 15 rounds and missed him. He kicked the car above the driver front tire and they started yelling at him. He then rammed his bike into the car.

[REDACTED] attempted to flee by going west on Mile Stretch Drive towards US Highway 19. The car pursued him and began firing more rounds from behind him. The car passed him and the passenger started firing backwards towards him. [REDACTED] was not hit.

[REDACTED] made it to the bus stop near WAWA on US Highway 19. There were other homeless at the bus stop and [REDACTED] told them he was shot at by a group of kids in a black car. He said the other homeless said it happened to them as well.

[REDACTED] stated the car was a black four door Accent, Elantra, or Optima. He said there was definitely four maybe five

people in the car. Two appeared to be "Spanish" and the front passenger may have been "Spanish". He said there were four boys and one girl. The driver was a slow talker and a bigger boy.

I asked [REDACTED] if he could positively the shooter and he said yes. He advised he had a conflict with them not to long ago while he was walking around. He said there were 6 kids the other day on three scooters. They approached him and he kept walking. They made comment to how brave he was to not move out of their way. He said he saw each one of them.

[REDACTED] stated the car stopped in front of the bus stop a while ago. The passengers were trying to pick a fight with them.

INTERVIEW #2: [REDACTED] stated the following:

[REDACTED] was riding his bike and the car approached him. They opened fire on him and struck him in the chest. He said he was hurting and scared. He advised it was the front passenger and it happened at the "19 bus stop". He said they shot at least BBs in rapid succession.

INVESTIGATION: On 08/25/18 at 0300 hours, I was travelling west bound on Mile Stretch Road heading to the WAWA located at 1919 US Highway 19. While at the Mile Stretch/US Highway 19 intersection stop light, my vehicle was facing west and I observed a black four-door sedan in the south bound lane of US Highway 19. The vehicle was resting in the deceleration lane for right turn only lane into Wawa. The black sedan was resting perpendicular to the bus stop with its four-way flashers on. The vehicle remained there almost the entire duration while I waited for the green signal light.

I observed the black sedan head south on US Highway 19 at an accelerated speed, used its right directional, and turn into the south entrance of WAWA. The black sedan went around WAWA in a clockwise direction and went back on US Highway 19 using the south entrance. The black sedan used its right directional to turn on to US Highway 19 and I observed the vehicle merge all the way over to the inside line while the right rear directional was flashing. The right rear directional was very distinct due to the fact the blinker was in rapid succession as if the light had an electrical short.

The traffic light turned green and I turned south on US Highway 19 and arrived at the WAWA. Upon my arrival, two white males, later identified as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] rapidly approached my vehicle while it was still in motion and utterly stated they were shot. [REDACTED] advised he was chased by a black sedan with four to five people and he was shot at multiple times. As the same time, [REDACTED] was making a similar statement while pulling his shirt up. I observed a deep purple mark on the left pectoral beside the nipple on [REDACTED]'s skin. I asked if the bullet was a BB or pellet and they both said yes. [REDACTED] stated it was a black Hyundai Sonata type vehicle and they both stated a couple "Hispanics" were in the vehicle. I asked if the vehicle just left WAWA and head south and they said yes. I asked if the vehicle was next to the bus stop and they said yes. I moved my vehicle to start the interview and then notified dispatch.

As I was about to start the interview, I observed a black sedan heading north on US Highway 19 and the vehicle came to rest at the Mile Stretch Drive and US Highway 19 intersection. I observed the right directional as rapidly flashing so I told the victims to stay at the location and I proceeded to attempt to locate the black sedan. The black sedan was last seen heading east on Mile Stretch Drive.

When I got on Mile Stretch Drive, I did not observe any vehicle lights or silhouette of any vehicle further east of my location. As I passed Abacus Road, I observed a dark color vehicle resting near the end of the road with the lights out. I stopped my vehicle next to the Fifth-Third Bank and backed-up to Abacus Road to make entry. While I

reversed my vehicle, I observed the brake light illuminate and only the left rear light was operational on the sedan. The vehicle slowly turned to the east and I initiated a felony stop due to unknown weapons involved. Five juveniles were detained.

I proceeded back to the WAWA at 1919 US Highway 19 to locate the victims to conduct an interview. I conducted a search throughout the Buena Vista area with negative results. [REDACTED] was finally located at the WAWA (see interview). I then drove [REDACTED] to Fifth-Third Bank to conduct a showing and [REDACTED] positively identified the shooter. I then returned to WAWA to drop [REDACTED] off. I located [REDACTED] behind the WAWA (see interview). I took photos of [REDACTED] I then went to the bus stop and located a blue paintball matching the same characteristics as the paintballs observed in the black sedan. I took photos of the bus stop and paintballs.

I returned back to Fifth-Third Bank. All five juveniles were arrested for aggravated battery with a deadly weapon. I transported the juvenile female to the Land O`Lakes Juvenile Detention Center without incident. Deputy Marrero and Deputy Roberts transported the remaining four juveniles to the same location (see supplement). Deputy Kluender had the vehicle impounded (see supplement).

While at the Land O`Lakes Detention Center, I determined the juveniles were not in a gang or gang affiliated.

My BWC was activated during this event. I later uploaded the video and photos to Evidence.com and submitted a copy of the Pasco County Complaint Affidavit to Records.

A wants and warrants check on all parties met with negative results.

No further action.

On 08/25/2018, at approximately 0319 hours, I responded to 1959 Abacus Road Holiday, FL 34691 in reference to an aggravated battery with a deadly weapon. Upon arrival, I assisted with taking in custody of five juvenile subjects wanted for questioning in the alleged incident. Each juvenile was Mirandized, provided a "yes" acknowledging their understanding of their Miranda rights and agreed to speak with me in reference to their involvement.

I began my first interview with Jenna Demers (17 yoa) as to her involvement. Jenna advised she was babysitting until approximately 0100 hours while her mother was out. She stated she received a text from her friends wanting to know if she wanted to hang out and ride around with them. She advised she took a shower, got dressed and was picked up from her house around 0130 hours. Jenna stated she was picked up by Daniel. Jenna advised Peter, Alex and Kie`Shawn were already in the vehicle when she was picked up. Jenna informed me her and her friends originally went to Checkers for food before they ended up at WaWa located at 1929 US Highway 19 Holiday, FL 34691. While at the WaWa, Jenna advised her and her friends got into with some homeless men. She stated there was an exchange of "yo momma" jokes before they drove away. She stated after that, the car she was in was pulled over and she was in handcuffs. Jenna was asked how she knew the other juveniles in the car. She informed me she went to school with all of them at Anclote High School. I asked her about the "BB gun" and the paint ball gun. She stated she didn`t know who they belonged to and they were already in the car when she was picked up. Jenna stated she didn`t she see anyone shoot either gun. This concluded my interview with Jenna.

Next I spoke with Daniel Alicea Jr. (17 yoa) as the events leading up to his car being pulled over. Daniel advised he only recently moved to Florida to live with his dad. He stated the vehicle he was driving is his car, but is registered to his dad. Daniel advised he worked until midnight at Ozona Blue. Once he was off work, he stated he asked his friends, Peter, Alex, Kieshawn and Jenna if they wanted to hang out and ride around. He advised Peter, Alex and Kie`Shawn me him at his house before they picked up Jenna. Daniel informed me they went to Checkers for food before going to the WaWa. At the WaWa, Daniel stated him and his friends got into it with unknown homeless men. He advised one of the homeless men ended up kicking his car. Daniel stated it pissed him off to the point he grabbed the pistol "BB gun" out of the glove box and shot the unknown homeless man two to three times initially, they left and circled back around with the man being shot again by Alex. Daniel informed me after such time they left the WaWa and were then pulled over by Sheriff`s deputies. It should be noted, Daniel was very cooperative and answered all of my questions. Daniel advised he was sorry for his actions and regrets that he even committed a crime. It should also be noted Daniel implicated Alex as the second shooter. This concluded my interview with Daniel.

I then spoke with Kie`Shawn Johnson as to the events that occurred. He advised he was staying the night at Alex and Peter`s house. They called up Daniel and asked him if he wanted to ride around and go to Checkers for food. Kie`Shawn advised he rode on a moped with Peter and Alex to Daniel`s house. After they went to Checkers, they rode up to WaWa where he stated they got into with some people and were talking about each other`s mothers.

Kie`Shawn informed me nothing else happened after that. Kie`Shawn was questioned about the "BB gun" and paint ball gun. He informed me the guns were already in the car and they belonged to Daniel. During the interview, Kie`Shawn was questioned as to who shot the guns. I specifically named each person in the car with him, asking if they shot either of the guns. He advised no one shot any of the guns. He also stated no one shot the paint ball because it did not work. Kie`Shawn maintained his story that no one shot any of the weapons, stating "I was in the backseat. I don`t know what happened." This concluded my interview with Kie`Shawn.

I next spoke with Alexandras. He stated he knew Kie`Shawn and Jenna from school. He advised he`s known Daniel for a while. Alex advised Daniel called him and asked if he wanted to drive around. He then stated he, Kie`Shawn and his brother went to Daniel`s house, and then they left and went to Checkers. When asked about the guns in the vehicle, Alex stated he didn`t know anything about any guns in the car. He stated they got into it with a male at the bus stop who they told to get out of the road. He advised the unknown male threatened them and then left on his bike. Alex stated no one fired the "BB gun" or the paint ball gun. Alex informed me they only got into with the unknown male and then left. Alex was adamant that no one in the car did anything nor did he see anyone do anything. This concluded my interview with Alex.

I last spoke with Peter Papisarantopoulos. He stated he was at work when Daniel called him stating he was getting off work and wanted to know if he wanted to ride around. He advised he and his brother Alex and Kie`Shawn rode mopeds to Daniel`s house and then left for Checkers. He informed me they picked up Jenna prior to going to Checkers. He stated he knew Jenna and Kie`Shawn from Anclote High School. Daniel he knew from a while back. Peter advised Daniel always keeps the "BB gun" in his car. Peter stated the paint ball was already in the car on the floor. Peter stated Daniel keeps the "BB gun" in the glove box but never saw it taken out of the glove box. Peter stated the only thing he did was throw the paint balls. He stated he didn`t shoot he paint ball because it didn`t work. As the other juveniles in the car, Peter was adamant no one shot any guns or weapons. When Peter was advised he was being taken to jail, he then wanted to be truthful and tell me what happened. Peter stated Daniel was the only person to shoot. He stated Daniel shot twice. Peter didn`t understand why he was going to jail but it was explained to him, if you ride around when others who commit crimes, you will held responsible as well. This concluded my interview with Peter.

At the conclusion of the above listed interviews, I had no other involvement.
